

LDTc AGILITY CLASS RULES

To keep both you and your dog from possible injury and health hazards, the following are strictly enforced:

1. Each dog enrolled in an agility course will be expected to have a sound working knowledge of come, sit, down & stay.
2. Dog/handlers attending class should be in good physical condition. This sport requires a great deal of running and jumping.
3. Only dogs attending classes will be allowed in the training area unless prior permission has been given by the Instructor(s).
4. All dogs undergoing instruction must have current inoculations. Proof of such inoculations will be required at the time of registration. If you are planning on pursuing agility titles, it is strongly recommended that you have your dog's eyes, hips & elbows checked.
5. Only a plain buckle collar will be used during training. Each student should provide a water bowl, toys, soft dog treats and bug spray for yourself and your dog.
6. Any dog in questionable physical health may not attend class. Bitches in season may attend, but must wear panties.
7. You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog.
8. Dogs will be restrained from any conduct deemed unacceptable and so indicated by course instructor. Dogs shall be restrained from needless barking. Any dog so unmanageable as to pose a hazard to other dogs or people will not be allowed to attend class until the owner can show reasonable control over it.
9. Any dog that displays aggressive behavior towards other dogs will be immediately dismissed.
10. Handlers must wear appropriate shoes and clothing. Agility is a fast paced activity for both handler and dog!
11. Handlers under the age of 16 must have parental approval, as well as Instructor approval.
12. Agility classes operate on a fixed schedule and are limited in size. Once a course begins there are no tuition refunds. In cases of inclement weather and subsequent cancellation of class, make up classes will be added to the end of the session. The Instructor(s) will call when canceling classes because of the weather.
